Whether you will be worshipping with us or not, we believe you will wish to have a memory of your departed loved ones included in the Yizkor Scroll of Remembrance Book. Special prayers for those recorded will be recited by the Rabbis. There is also a permanent Yahrtzeit plaque on which you can have their names permanently inscribed.
